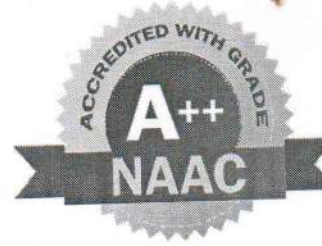

Agenda 4: Programme Learning Outcomes (PLOs) & Course Learning Outcomes (CLOs)

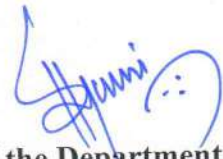
The Board reviewed and approved the **Programme Learning Outcomes (PLOs)**, emphasizing:

2. Comprehensive knowledge of Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS).
3. Research aptitude and analytical skills.
4. Translation and communication skills.
5. Ethical and constitutional values.
6. Employability and entrepreneurial skills.
7. Critical and analytical thinking.
8. Philosophical understanding.
9. Multidisciplinary knowledge base.
10. Deep understanding of Indian Poetics, Criticism, Ethics, and Cultural Engagement.

The Board also formally approved the **Course Learning Outcomes (CLOs)** as reflected unit-wise within the syllabus.

The Board of Studies formally discussed, finalized, and approved all the aforementioned agendas. It was unanimously recommended that the complete documentation be forwarded to higher university authorities for formal consideration and implementation starting from the **Academic Session 2026**.
