Programme Objectives for M.A Sanskrit

The M.A. Sanskrit Programme is a two-year course divided into four semesters. The Programme follows UGC recommended Choice Based Credit System with Core Course, Discipline Centric Elective, Generic Electives and Open Electives.

The M.A Sanskrit Programme Objectives are as follows:

- To introduce and sensitize the students to a broader aspect of courses including Vedic Literature and classical Literature of Sanskrit.
- To introduce students to historical and cultural perspective of literary trends in Sanskrit Literature.
- To enable students to develop analytical skills in order to comprehend and appreciate thematic and aesthetic dimension of Sanskrit Literary texts.
- To develop communication skills and knowledge of students reading and writing through skill-based course of Sanskrit.
- To foster a critical understanding of ideas and concepts generated through Indian Knowledge system as preserved in Sanskrit text and equip students to apply these to real life.
- To familiarize students with native and indigenous literature including Kashmir based Sanskrit Literature and philosophy like Purana Literature, Indian Poetics, Kashmir Shaivism etc., keeping in view the recommendations of NEP-2020.
- To acquire necessary methodologies and pedagogy to pursue a career in teaching and research.
- To develop ability of research, analysis and evaluation through using rare texts of Sanskrit.
- To develop critical understanding of Indian Knowledge system and create awareness among common people.
- To enable students to acquire holistic development.
- To motivate and prepare students for competitive and eligibility examination like NET, SET, UPSC, PCS etc. thereby them secure employment.

Syllabus for M.A Sanskrit (CBCS)

A student pursuing M.A in Sanskrit has to earn 12 credits from **Core Courses (CR)**, 08 credits from a pool of **Discipline Centric Elective (DCE)** from the department of Sanskrit in each semester. In addition to these a student has to opt for at least 4 credits from **Generic Elective (GE)** and **Open Elective courses (OE)**. The minimum number of credits to be earned by the students in each semester is 24 and 96 credits in the whole course.
